1960

12th June a meeting, called by the Hamersley Sporting Bodies Association, was held with district residents to discuss a proposal by the Perth Road Board to establish lawn tennis courts in the Hamersley District.

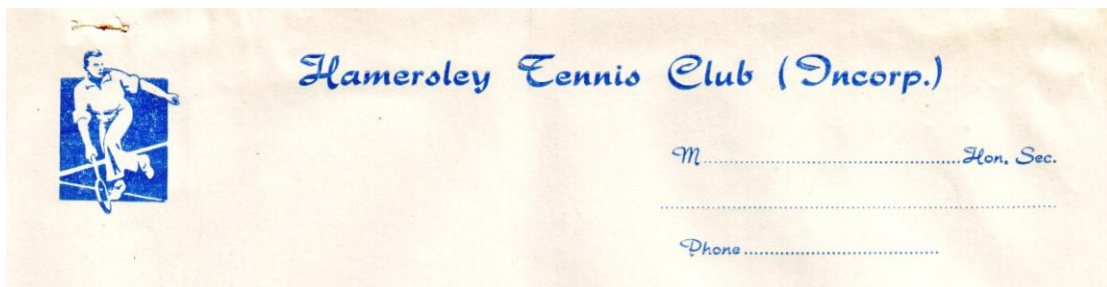
18th June Hamersley Tennis Club Inc. formed. Meeting held at Riley Memorial Oval Reserve

Membership nomination fee was 5 shillings

Secretary N Clarke Treasurer G Horsfel

Initial membership nomination 5/- , minutes Hamersley Tennis Club 22nd June
23rd June adopted rules & procedures of Mt Lawley Tennis Club as they best suited to the club's requirements.



1961

The area set aside for 8 grass courts was levelled (courts 5-12)

1962

19th March fees set at a meeting held at RSL Hall North Beach

Adults nomination - £2.2.0 membership £6.0.0 (couple £10)

Juniors - 1.10.0 4.0.0 (16-19years)

2.00 (less than 16)

April club emblem colours chosen - maroon & gold

The original clubhouse (early 1960s) commenced as just an ablution block and then added to over several years. It was a basic garage like construction of brick walls and flat steel roof.

1963

7th November resolved to let schools hire courts for £5 per day per court

23rd November application to take over the lease of the courts from the City of Perth

1964

Lease signed, for land & buildings, with City of Perth rent was £100 per year.

22nd November official opening of the Hamersley Tennis Club.

December total membership of 120, bank balance £200

4 more grass courts built (courts 13-16)

1972

North Beach and Districts Sportsmen's Club Inc. It consisted of 3 sections

- North Beach Tennis club,
- North Beach Bowling club
- North Beach Dart club

1975

City of Stirling agreed to construct 2 hard courts, north of clubrooms.(in the current car park)

1976

"Only two members attended the Busy bee last Saturday' - executive meeting October 1976

1977

Approval of practice wall paid by City of Stirling est cost, \$4000? Patio added to front of tennis pavilion, paid for by City of Stirling

"L Crook proposed that entry fee for Handicap Events be set at \$1/event. Carried" - executive meeting March 1977

"We are only just keeping our heads above water..... a number of reasons

- 1) The decline in membership
- 2) The lack of a social committee
- 3) Unsatisfactory financial arrangements with the Sportsmen Club "agm 1977

1979

"Sportsmen's Club - To the parents who take children to the club, please see that they do not touch the ladies pennant board..... Apparently children have been shifting name tags around which has caused some understandable frustrations and problems when the ladies have gone to the board to check on their pennant arrangements". net prophet

"For the first time in the club's history one of our members has been successful in the annual WALTA Champion of Champions event, which matches the Club Champions from all WALTA affiliated Clubs against each other. Bruce Elliott had a straight sets win in Division III of the event..... " net prophet April 1979

"Annual Dinner Dance..... There is a 5 course meal with a choice of menu, and a 5 piece band...and the price of \$14 includes all drinks....as a special bonus we have arranged..... NO boring speeches" net prophet April 1979

1980

"Would you (Ms member) like a new set of kitchen cutlery? If so why not donate your existing collection to the Club & then put the bite on the old man? Then he Club can cut out borrowing from the bowlers and can spoon feed you at the same time." net prophet November 1980

"Care for Kids – Your committee, who all love children... make the following heartfelt pleas to parents – Please instruct your children to move slowly and quietly in the Clubroom. It is not a football field or skating rink..... Please ask them not to sit at the organisers' table colouring in set roster cards....." net prophet December 1980

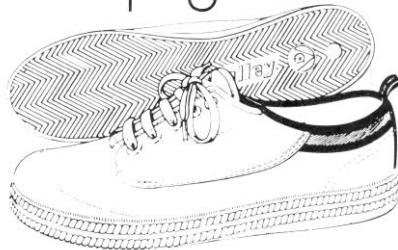

1982

NBDSC sold \$200 debentures (repayable over 8 years, 12 % interest), to raise money for building extensions. There was a lack of support by tennis members initially.

City of Stirling agreed to construct 4 more hard courts

1983

Four hard courts built (courts 17 – 20) Approx cost \$50,000. Funded by City of Stirling \$20,000, Department of Youth Sport & Recreation \$10,000, Club cash \$5,000, Commonwealth Trading Bank loan \$15,000. 15 Club members were guarantors on this loan.

2 courts lit - 4 poles @12.3m \$743 each, 2 poles @12.1m \$876 each. (courts 17 & 18)??Riverton Engineering.

1982/83 3 pennant shields won, NBTC had a total of twenty summer teams. Enlarged and more modern sportsman club house.

1984

21st February – Dept. of Youth Sport & Recreation grant on \$ for \$ basis for purchase of mower & windbreak – cost \$2058

City of Stirling handed management of hard courts (granulated rubber courts?) to club.

\$22,000 awarded by Council for extension of clubhouse but committee looking at relocation or extension.

At the AGM of the tennis section of North Beach & District Sportsmen Club it was suggested to the new committee that

A yearly calendar be issued to all members, scrourgers commence, tournament every third Sunday, remove ball fees and have a social sub committee.

6 shields won in summer pennants

1985

Formation of North Beach Tennis Club Inc., secession from North Beach & Districts Sportsmen's Club Inc. The first AGM was held on 30th July.

February – pergola constructed by members

May - PO Box 117, North Beach rented

City of Stirling provided lighting for remaining two plexipave courts (19 & 20), installed speed humps in car park, footpath on Wilberforce St, new grassed area & retaining wall.

“The two hard courts have been included in our existing lease which will represent a saving to the club on hire charges and produce revenue for the club” - AGM 30/7/85.

Hiring of 2 hard courts in Wilberforce St cost \$2.40 day time

Hiring of 4 hard courts attached to grass courts \$3 day time due to superior quality

July Dept. of Youth Sport & Recreation grant “of up to \$385 to assist with the purchase of mower, brushcutter & tennis nets.”

1986

January Commodore Motors Volvo 1986 – Northern Suburbs Junior Tournament held – no. of entrants 232, no. of matches scheduled 330.

“.. player behaviour was very satisfactory, Committee had more hassles from parents.” Tournament report

Application for key to courts & clubhouse was a \$20 bond & \$6.35 one of payment for cost of cutting the key.

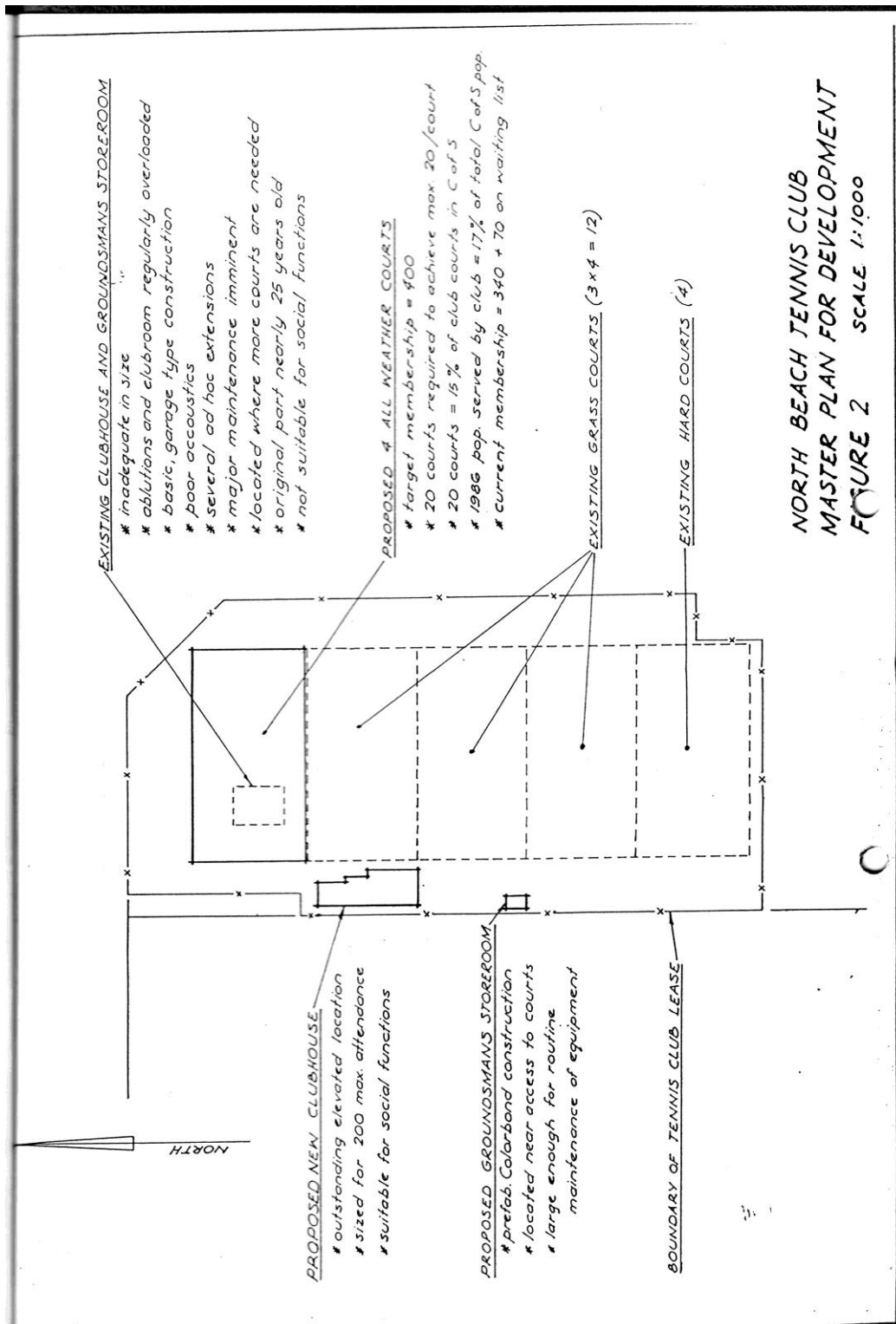

1987

April building of the new clubhouse commenced. Kib Homes P/L was the building company.

Building sub committee-

“Ken Paulsen (the builder)

Raph Upton (the organiser)

Don Coultas (the financier)

Rod Burton the (engineer)” - agm 1987

Total cost of building \$232,000 City of Stirling financed \$165,000 of the amount. Self help from the members towards building costs, walls, pathways & reticulation was valued at \$44,000. A total of 187 members assisted during construction.

October 17th official opening of current club house, by the Mayor of Stirling, Mr George Strickland at 5pm. Preceded by an exhibition tennis match

Membership Card issued instead of shoe tags, which were rarely worn.

Automatic Reticulation system installed, previously moveable aluminium irrigation pipes were used.

1988

8 Summer Pennant shields won. Pennant cards had to be taken into the West Australian Saturday & Sunday nights. First time NBTC had a State Grade team

Groundsman - Mark Watson (Sandover Medalist –Perth Football Club) had to terminate his contract due to a broken ankle.

January – NBTC held Northern Suburbs Junior Tournament & Australian 12 & under lead in Tournament.

1989

Courts 1-4 construction, synthetic grass at a cost of. \$130,900. City of Stirling (\$83,700) and NBTC (\$47,200). Tennis Courts (WA)

At the AGM Midweek (associate) category replaced provisional category. Social membership category was created. Shoe tags were reintroduced.

1989/90 23 adult pennant teams played.

The club house became a smoke free area.

1990

City of Stirling and NBTC jointly funded the hit up wall, limestone surrounds. The cost was \$19000. NBTC contributed \$4000 which was the difference between the cost of a standard 9m x 12m wall to the 15m x 15m wall requested by the club.

The height of the BBQ brick wall was extended. Extra balustrading & new BBQs installed

Teams tennis Thursday night inter club competition” “ ...on Finals Night the Scrubbers eventually won in an exciting match. And to add to the excitement of the night Gerry Cohen had his trousers ripped off him during the match...”

1991

“An analysis of the workings of the executive follows.

Tennis Director – Numerous responsibilities which demand no more than 23 hours a day

Finance Director ... must be able to count,..stamp collectors and former politicians need not apply

Members Directors (2) Very easy job as members never complain about sets, gradings or anything else. ..

House & Gardens Director ... knowledge of court maintenance.and the ability to differentiate between grass, synthetic and plexipave courts an advantage.”

Net prophet no3 1991/1992

At the AGM plans were announced to have computerised set making. Cost of computer and program was approx. \$2500.

1992

The bubbling on the synthetic courts (1-4) was solved by slits in the surface.

Dinner Dance and Presentation Night held at Underwater world, 160 attended at \$20 per head

1993

light poles for synthetic courts (1-4) Electek cost was \$28715 The Great M&M Drive was held to help finance the lights, \$4500 was raised.

At an EGM the financial year was moved to become May 1 to April 30.

1995

A motion re land swap deal between City of Stirling and Meath Homes was passed at Council.

Water Pump (\$4400) Western Irrigation P/L and computer (\$2600) were replaced

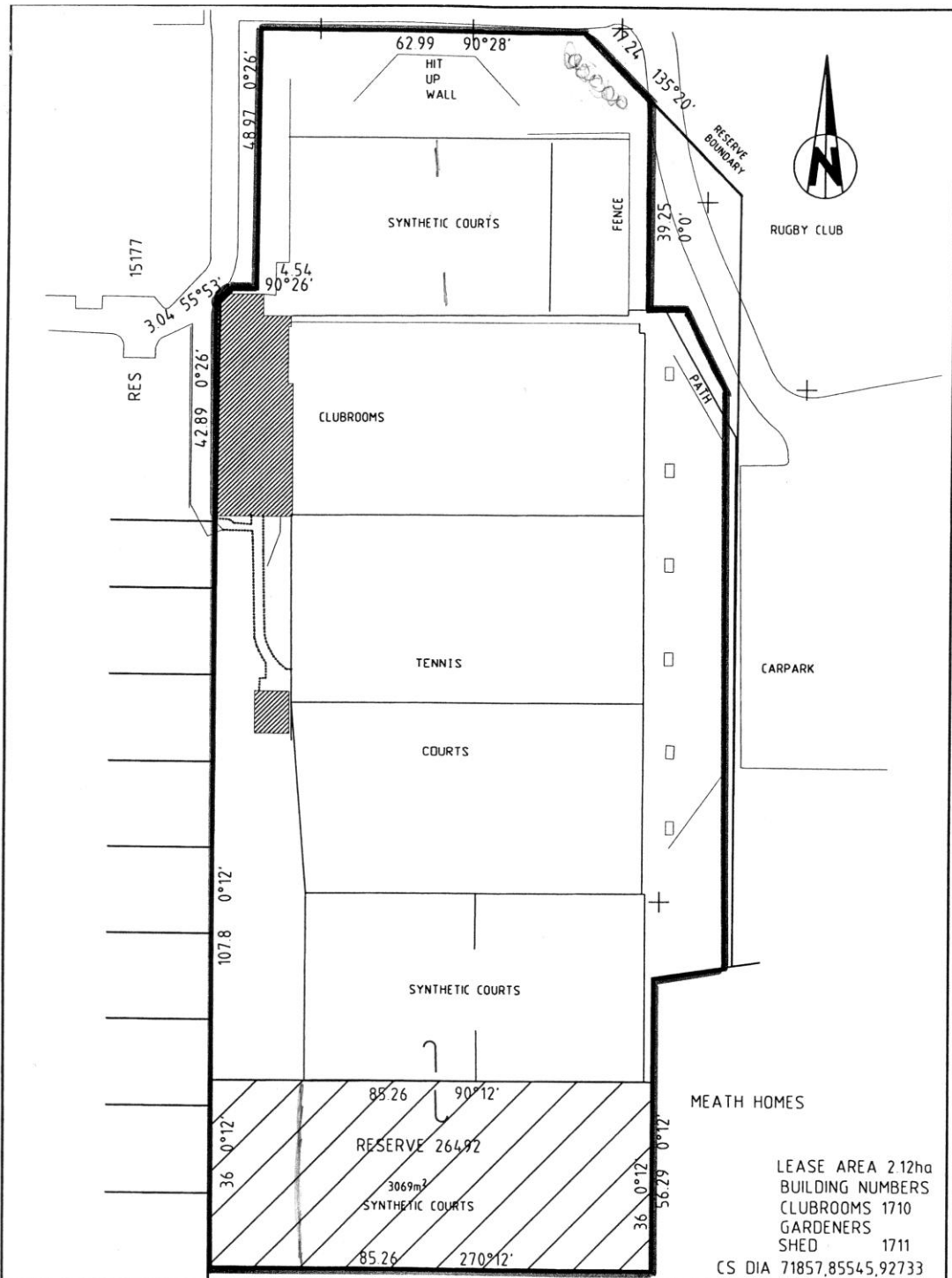
Oct. Tennis courts WA restored courts 17-20 cost \$14470. City of Stirling 50%

1996

Tightening of security – a key could be purchased for \$25

Replaced surface on courts 1-4. Tennis Courts (WA) , Ian Williams, extra 10 synthetic grass. City of Stirling grant was \$21593 which was 50% of the cost of resurfacing.

Purchases during the year – 16 new nets, spectator shelter, spray equipment (\$188), lawn mower (\$3700), Lawn groomer (\$1600), dishwasher (\$800)
